2020 brought a lot of changes and challenges to the World, and the COVID-19 pandemic certainly impacted Snake River Animal Shelter and its operations. It was not the year we had planned for, but thanks to our supporters and dedicated staff and volunteers, we managed to still follow our mission: ***To improve and save animal lives by promoting quality care and compassion through adoption and humane education in the region.***

While the shelter had to temporarily close its door to the public in the past year, we never stopped taking care of the animals in need: Our organization provided a temporary home to more than 1,000 animals.
